"I saw a picture of a dry land with a hot sun. Many people were sitting happily in the shade of trees, drinking cocktails keen to escape the heat of the sun and the brightness of its light. Then there were other people. These were clearly unafraid of the heat and the light. They basked in it and welcomed even hotter and even brighter days. Remarkably, they were not outwardly burned but looked like those who were empowered by the light and who were on fire in their souls and in their hearts with a joy unspeakable and full of glory. Indeed, the day did get hotter and what little shade there was disappeared. This led to the rejoicing of those that were basking in it but in contrast, great fear in those who were trying to hide in the shade. Those that continued to try to escape the heat and the light grew ever more fearful and became filled with dread as the shade gradually disappeared.
