God - Elohim

- Creator of all things (Isaiah 40:28)
- *Have you not known? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable.
- and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things, (Ephesians 3:9)
- Sustains all things (Hebrews 1:3)
- *He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power
- *He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. (Colossians 1:17)

Incomparable

Isaiah 40:21-23

Do you not know? Do you not hear?
Has it not been told you from the beginning?
Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth?

It is he who sits above the circle of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers; who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them like a tent to dwell in; who brings princes to nothing, and makes the rulers of the earth as emptiness.
